4. BOARD DISCUSSION AND ACTION ITEMS

a) **Art Piano Donation— Thea Henney (20 minutes)**

Sherri Smoot would like to donate a 1898 upright grand piano for the Art Pianos For All project. It might be possible to host a piano at CREATE PC. We can apply for 2025 RAP grant funding to decorate the piano. The piano is located at Sherri's daughter's house in Kamas.

Piano dimensions:

Length: 58.5 inches

Depth: 28.5 inches

Height: 56 inches

Tuning: A professional tuner said it cannot be tuned to perfect pitch, and is ½ step off.

Timeline: The piano can remain in Kamas until spring; the timeline is flexible.

Delivery Fee: Piano movers quoted between \$300-450, depending on stairs in the pickup location. Awaiting Sherri's response to see if she will include this expense as part of her donation. If not we could request this in a RAP grant, perhaps.

i) Discuss accepting an additional Art Piano

Given the piano's tuning issues, it would not be suitable for programming with the symphony musicians, but would be acceptable for community use. The Arts Council is willing to accept the piano at CREATE PC, and there is the potential to store it when CREATE PC eventually moves to a new location, but we do not know what future facilities will look like.

Thea will email Dave at Barrus Pianos and ask if the piano being ½ step off is a problem for community use, and see if he has any advice, as well as ask about the pitches on the current Art Pianos for comparison. Thea will see if Sherri is willing to donate the delivery fee.

b) Favorite Public Art Piece Presentation — Lisa Bedell (5 minutes)

i) Painted garages and murals in the Barrio del Oeste in Salamanca, Spain. Please check out Lisa's images [here](#), as well as a few in the Board Packet.

[Galería Urbana](#) is located in a Barrio just outside the city center, and features over 200 murals painted onto garage doors and walls in the neighborhood. The project began in 2013 when the Neighborhood Association invited 25 young artists to create murals, and since then more murals have been added year after year. There is a map and legend for the murals, as well as an app, which are a great attraction for tourists and students. Lisa stumbled upon this landmark while studying Spanish in Salamanca.

Artists have been selected for the bus shelter project, and art has been installed in the library study rooms, most of which were created by local artists. A piece of art has been selected for the creekside bike park shade structure.

ii) Arts Council of Park City & Summit County Update — Jocelyn Scudder (5 minutes)
The Arts Council is in a data collection period for the Arts & Culture Master Plan, and Arts Council Staff will send the survey to the Board. Before February there will be focus groups, which the Board is welcome to participate in, perhaps as a co-meeting with PCPAAB. There is also a template available for anyone wishing to host a focus group. CREATE PC Holiday Makers Market will be open through Sundance, and will change over in early February.

d) Budget Updates - Dan Compton/Thea Henney (5 minutes)

The budget passed, and the County is working on a new contract with the Arts Council.
