4. BOARD DISCUSSION AND ACTION ITEMS

a) **RAP Grant+Future Project Planning — Jocelyn Scudder (45 minutes)**

i) The 2025 RAP Cultural Grant deadline is March 31. The Board must discuss and prioritize which projects it would like to seek funding for during this grant cycle.

Admin met with Madlyn McDonough who works in the Summit County Planning Department. She has engaged a graduate student to help in putting together an Arts Implementation Plan for the Rail Trail, which should be completed later in the Spring. The Plan recommends phased work beginning in Coalville and progressing geographically. The concept is Quilting Together the Rail Trail, which engages the strong quilting history of Summit County. The proposed pilot project i Coalville would act as a gateway to the Rail Trail. There would be the possibility of getting supplementary funds from the County if RAP were to partially fund the project.

ii) Vote for which projects to seek RAP grant funding.

Jenny makes a motion to pursue a RAP grant request of \$60k for the Rail Trail Coalville Gateway project, giving Jocelyn leeway to adjust the amount while keeping the board apprised. Lisa seconds, all vote in favor and the motion passes at 4:41pm.

b) Roundabouts Community Engagement Plan Update — Thea Henney (10 minutes)

We have had positive responses from Ecker Hill, Weilenmann, and Park city Day School and are coordinating assemblies and visits to classrooms. Staff spoke to the artists about including more schools in the County in the naming contest, and have a few options including a widespread digital campaign and possibly a ballot box at Swaner EcoCenter. The artists are having a meeting today with engineers to get footing plans for the crane sculpture finalized.

c) Favorite Public Art Piece Presentation — Jocelyn Scudder (10 minutes)

- i) Jocelyn will present Designing Local's notes from the Public Art Roundtable on Feb. 21. This roundtable set the stage for the public and consultants to know we have very active public art boards. There was talk about looking ahead and working to get public art on trailheads, in neighborhoods, and the Bonanza parcel once it is developed. There were questions about what kinds of stories the public and Board members want told through public art. Some answers included: mining legacy, olympics, nature, Indigenous histories, sports and agriculture, pioneer history, contemporary stories, and untold, lesser-known stories. There was also a desire for public art to showcase the mini-cultures within communities, and to increase youth engagement. The differences between permanent and temporary public art installations were discussed. More public arts funds are needed in order to grow staff capacity and realize the impact the Board members desire. Some possibilities to expand impact include public-private partnerships, and creating regional approach to public art within Summit County that innovates ways for private developers to include public art in their projects.
