a) Sheriff and Attorney Office Expansion Public Art Opportunity— Dan Compton (45 minutes)

i) Discuss the possibility of producing public artworks as part of the sheriff and attorney office expansion project. The Office Expansion is a \$24 million project which does qualify for the 1% for Public Art campaign. Please see the attached document in the Board Packet for more information.

[This project qualifies for the 1% for art policy, and there are items in the budget could be repurposed to include artworks, such as a cable railing on the stairway, exterior sunshades, and exterior benches and planters. Staff will need to meet with County officials and the building architects in order to get a firm sense of the possibilities for themes and other information relevant to developing an RFP for these projects.](#)

ii) Vote for a course of action, if necessary.

b) Roundabouts Community Engagement Plan Update — Thea Henney (10 minutes)

The artists are scheduled to visit 3 local schools on April 24 and 25, and Arts Council staff is putting together a presentation for teachers at the 4th school to share with students to teach them about the sculptures and involve them in the naming contest. There is the potential for ballot boxes at Swaner Ecocenter and the Libraries, and **staff will work on creating the digital assets and signage for this.**

 - i) Megan will present on [A Mindful Bridge](#) from the Denver Public Art Collection [A Mindful Bridge Encourages mindfulness through public art](#), and there is the possibility of adding to it in future. This is a case where public art is helping meet the challenge of enticing people to cross a bridge where it is noisy and high up, but which connects two important neighborhoods.
