4. BOARD DISCUSSION AND ACTION ITEMS

a) **Sheriff and Attorney Office Expansion Public Art Opportunity update— Dan Compton (15 minutes)**

i) Dan, Jocelyn, and Thea met with County officials and the project architects on May 5th and will provide updates on this opportunity to the Board from that meeting.

Staff met with the project architects and with County officials twice, and Board member Jörg was present at one of those meetings. It seems most feasible given the time and budget constraints to put out an RFP this year for 7 artistic benches to be placed outside the building with a budget of \$42,000 (\$6,000/bench). Further funding to support the remaining 7 planned benches can be put into the budget request for 2026, along with a request for artistic paneling on the interior railing. In the meantime, a railing will be installed with temporary panels. Staff will begin working on an RFP for the initial 7 benches, and will collaborate with County staff and the architects to determine appropriate themes. Staff will also work on a budget request for the 2026 funds for the railing and remaining 7 benches. Jörg and Georgia can join additional meetings with architects and County staff to understand the railing limitations and confer about preferred materials.

b) Roundabouts Community Engagement Plan Update — Thea Henney (15 minutes)

i) Update on school visits with artist team

The schools and students were excited to participate in the artist presentations and to have a stake in naming the statues. Don & Lisa visited Park city Day School, Weilenmann School of Discovery, and Ecker Hill Middle School

ii) Jeremy Ranch Elementary School involvement/Spring Arts Fest May 2 (see slideshow created for JRES in Board Packet)

Dan tabled at the school's Spring Arts Festival, and there was a lot of excitement and positive response to the crane maquette and the sculpture project. Staff sent JRES teachers a slide show with videos, photos, and written information about the sculptures to generate excitement in the student body and help facilitate the naming contest.

iii) Timeline for naming campaign

Names will be collected from the 4 schools by May 30, and staff will launch the County-wide digital campaign in June. Final names for the sculptures will be announced in early July after the installation is complete.

This artist is focused on public art that encourages community engagement and gathering. If you deep dive the projects on his website they all have interesting community engagement components. Mazzotta views public art as a mechanism and tool for community building. SLC Arts Council is working with him now, so he will be in Utah soon! All of his projects include "community living rooms" before each piece is created, where the artist sets up a living room in a public space and sits with community members to talk about what they want to see in their area.

- i) Park City Public Art Advisory Board (PCPAAB) — Jocelyn Scudder (5 minutes)
PAAB has selected the local artist for the MARC pool fencing, and is moving forward with installation over the next 6-8 months. They are considering a phase 2 for the bus shelter artworks, and are working with the transit department. The community center in City Park is getting remodeled, and 1% will go towards artistic rubber flooring in the playground.
- ii) Arts Council of Park City & Summit County Update — Jocelyn Scudder (5 minutes)
The Arts Council has multiple calls out for artists- for Sunrise on Sunset Chairlifts and Summit Arts Market. SAM will take place on June 12, and the Latino Arts Festival will be June 13-15. They are nearing the end of the Arts & Culture Master Planning process, and Jcoelyn will speak with City Council May 15. She will also be on the Mountain Life radio show for an hour. South Salt Lake City has 13 new large scale murals going up as part of an event on Saturday.
