**4. BOARD DISCUSSION AND ACTION ITEMS**

a) **Washakie Shipping Update— Thea Henney (3 minutes)**

The exhibit shipped successfully and was received by UWY. The final cost was \$546.43.

b) **Sunrise Rotary Grant Discussion— Jocelyn Scudder (15 minutes)**

\$500 were awarded for Art Piano maintenance and programming

i) Discuss possible allocations for funding received

Possible uses of the funding include programming for next Summer's Art Piano concerts and the replacement of the Newpark Piano with a donated piano in better shape from Barrus Pianos. Barrus has offered to remove the old piano and replace it with a newer one for the cost of moving the pianos (approximately \$400- rough estimate).

ii) Vote on a course of action, if necessary

Betsey makes a motion to wait until the new Board Members are onboarded to decide what to do with the funds, but the motion fails at 4:15pm

Jenny motions to move forward with the new funding to replace the Newpark Art Piano, and to subsequently seek additional funding for an artist to decorate the piano Heather seconds the motion, and it passes at 4:15pm

**c) RAP Gateway Project Update— Thea Henney (5 minutes)**

Madlyn and Jessica have a meeting with state parks and trails today. Thea will follow up with them to see what they have learned.

**d) Roundabouts Sculptures Update — Thea Henney (3 minutes)**

The sculptures have been installed, and the artists are getting final approval from the engineering and building departments. We have received overwhelmingly positive feedback about the sculptures from community members on social media and in person. One anonymous caller said they don't like the sculptures, but most people seem thrilled. We have over 550 online responses to the naming contest so far.

In the middle of the month there will be a press release for the naming contest results. Arts Council staff will discuss with their PR specialist the possibility of pushing this out to KSL and other larger news outlets.

Megan makes a motion to vote in Georgia as the Vice Chair, Heather seconds. The motion passes unanimously at 4:23pm

**f) Farewell and Thank You to the Exiting Board Members— Thea Henney (5 minutes)**

Matt, Betsey, Jenny, and Maureen have helped us install numerous public artworks and served the community with dedication and thoughtfulness. All have been on the Board for many terms, and we are so grateful for their leadership and vision which has enlivened Summit County Public Art.

PCPAAB is in the middle of many projects, including the installation of bus stop artworks and a shade structure which will be done by the end of August. The RFP is live for the playscape surface, and power boxes are getting wrapped as the final phase of the project comes to a close.

Summit Arts Market will be July 12 at the Oakley Red Barn. It is a free community arts event featuring 40+artists and creative vendors.

The Summit County Fair Fine Arts Exhibit needs 2 Board Members to help lead and provide direction for County Council to select an adult and youth piece for purchase. This is one of the ways the Summit county collection acquires new pieces. Thea will send out emails about this volunteer opportunity.

Bob Devaney expresses that he has watched process for the roundabout sculptures from day 1 and it's an amazing process. He says the naming contest is impactful, and that the hands-on process of public engagement has resulted in community names for the sculptures.

Since staff has not yet heard about the Board Members openings, the timing of the interviews for potential new Board Members might be delayed. Thea will ask Amy Jones about the timing of the interviews with Shayne, and it may result in either a canceled August meeting or a meeting where no quorum is present and no votes can be made.
