**4. BOARD DISCUSSION AND ACTION ITEMS**

**a) Introduce new Board Members — Thea Henney (15 minutes)**

[Robert \(Bob\) Devaney](#) has lived in Summit County for 25 years. He has been on the Olympic planning committee, and worked for the US Ski Team and on the hockey rink. He was once on the Arts Council, and says his art interest began as a kid, and grew when he took art classes in college. He believes that Arts & Culture bring Summit County together.

[Marion Zaniello](#) moved to Park City in 2018 from Seattle. She has worked as a fashion designer and has a small skiwear business. She feels the vibrancy of the arts in Summit County is reflected across disciplines. She feels very supported by CREATE PC and the local arts community, and thinks public art is a way to demonstrate our community's values and character to visitors as well as residents.

Possible future projects discussed include:

- Considering the upcoming Olympics and getting RFPs out by 2032
- Possible light murals during the Olympics
- Placing more art in Kimball Junction
- Artworks on pedestrian over/underpasses
- Artworks for the upcoming new transit center
- Artworks on the driving overpass at I-80 and frontage road

**c) County Fair Art Exhibit Selected Artworks — Thea Henney (3 minutes)**

Both first choice artists agreed to sell their paintings, and are coming to the next County Council meeting. Sabina Morrey (adult) and Raylan Woolsey (youth) are thrilled to have their pieces purchased by the County.

SCPAAB staff will decide internally where to hang these pieces once the purchase is finalized. Most pieces go to the County Courthouse, but sometimes the youth pieces go to one of the libraries.

**d) Newpark Piano Replacement Update — Thea Henney (3 minutes)**

Staff is coordinating with SCPAAB's Newpark Hotel contact and Barrus Pianos to arrange a date for the piano replacement.

**e) Rail Trail RFP update — Thea Henney (3 minutes)**

Staff is securing a letter of permission from the Parks Department for the installation of artworks and the RFP is being edited by the Planning Department and will then go to the County Attorney for final approval.

**f) SO/AO RFP Update — Thea Henney (3 minutes)**

Staff is setting up a meeting with the sheriff's office to talk over artistic themes and acquire building information and images of the installation site.

**g) Leaf Dancer Sculpture Repairs Update — Thea Henney (3 minutes)**

The Sculpture has been damaged, and staff is in touch with artist Milt Neely about the possibility of repairing or deaccessioning the sculpture.

PCPAAB has finished a series of 8 bus stops in partnership with the transit department. Last night they worked on selecting an artist for the 1% project at the community center for artful playground surfacing. Artful bike racks will start installation in 2026. Some power boxes that had rusted were replaced and are getting wrapped.

Monster Drawing Rally is this weekend. It is a live drawing event where art is created live and auctioned off immediately. It benefits the Arts Council and the Kimball Art Center, and is a ton of fun.

The budget was largely well-received by the Budget Committee, with the exception of the \$60,000 requested for the Rail trail project. Dan will have a budget update soon.
