## Submittal Requirements

Additional details may be needed to ensure staff have sufficient information for analysis. All information submitted will be available for public review.

- Preliminary title report (dated within 30 days from the date of application submittal)
  
- Existing conditions record of survey (*drawn to scale*) that has been filed with the office of the Summit County Recorder and complies with State Code 17-73-504 – including:
  - existing easements, whether of public record or not
  - existing roads and other public or private rights-of-way
  - existing ditches, streams, lakes, ponds, or other water bodies
  - existing structures and their setbacks from all property lines
  - delineation of wetlands, floodplains, slopes exceeding 30%, geologic hazards, ridgelines, and avalanche zones
  - any other existing conditions not identified above
  
- Proposed preliminary subdivision plat prepared by a surveyor or engineer licensed in the State of Utah (*drawn to scale*) - including:
  - a subdivision name that is distinct from any subdivision name on a plat recorded in the County Recorder's Office
  - the boundaries course and dimensions of all the parcels of ground divided, by their boundaries, course and extent, whether the owner proposed that any parcel of ground is intended to be used as a street or for any other public use, and whether any such area is reserved or proposed for dedication for a public purpose
  - the lot or unit reference, block or building reference, street or site address, street name or coordinate address, acreage or square footage for all parcels, unit or lots, and length and width of the blocks and lots intended for sale
  - every existing right-of-way and recorded easement located within the plat for:
    - an underground facility
    - a water conveyance facility
    - any other utility facility
  - Any water conveyance facility located, entirely or partially, within the plat that:
    - is not recorded
    - of which the owner of the land has actual or constructive knowledge, including from information made available to the owner of the land, in the State Engineer's inventory of canals or from a licensed surveyor



## PRELIMINARY SUBDIVISION PLAT APPLICATION REVIEW PROCESS

### **Pre-Application Meeting**

The applicant is advised to set up a meeting with a planner to discuss concept plans prior to submitting an application.



### **Preliminary Subdivision Application Submittal**

- The applicant submits the application to [www.planningapplications@summitcountyutah.gov](mailto:www.planningapplications@summitcountyutah.gov).



### **Staff Completeness Check**

- The application is assigned to a planner.
- The planner sends a status letters to the applicant to convey if the application is complete or incomplete.
  - If incomplete, the applicant will be provided a list of the required materials.
  - If complete, the review process begins.



### **Preliminary Review**

- Planning staff and service providers review the application for compliance with relevant Codes. Planning staff will send a comprehensive list of comments to the applicant.

Occurs within 15 business



### **Planning Commission Meeting**

- Based on the ability to comply with relevant Codes and service provider requirements, planning staff will recommend approval or denial of the Preliminary Subdivision Plat to the Planning Commission.
- The Planning Commission will hold one public hearing and make a decision on the application.

Maximum of one public hearing



### **Preliminary Approval**

A preliminary approval letters will all comments and conditions of approval will be sent to the applicant.

### **Denial**

The applicant will receive a letter with details as to why the proposal was denied. The decision can be appealed to the County Council within 10 days.
